Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present:

Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee Milenkovic moved, duly seconded by Trustee White to Pass and Approve Ordinance 2023-02, "An Ordinance Authorizing and Approving a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Stickney Firefighters Teamster Local Union 700 for the Village of Stickney"

Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Prior to the vote Mayor Walik explained to all the police and fire in the audience that he and the entire Board are big supporters of the First Responders. A whole team together put this Union Contract. The Mayor asked them to introduce themselves. Justin introduced himself as the Union Steward for the Stickney Fire Department Teamsters. He introduced Eric and Evan. He explained that he has been here for seven years. We love what we do. We will continue to do that every day that we come to work. The Mayor explained that this contract is actually up for renewal in May. Many surrounding communities actually are late in renewing their contracts. It took us three meetings of maybe one hour each to resolve. Our Police Department negotiated for three hours, and it was done. The Mayor thanked the team, the Fire Chief, and the men and women of the fire department for what they do every day. He continued saying that there are surrounding communities that on days they do not have a full station. We assist them. We never had that problem here.

The Mayor read the following notice: Dated December 17, 2022: On January 4, 2023 the on-duty crew was dispatched to a patient that was unconscious. The crew found the patient unconscious on the floor. The person's son was home and said he heard the patient fall. The victim was face down on the floor. That police officer started CPR on the patient until the firefighters got there. The fire department found that the individual had a heart attack. They performed CPR and established a pathway.

The crew then applied the defibrillator pads on the patient's chest and delivered two shocks and were able to regain a pulse for this victim. The crew transferred the patient to the ambulance and then the hospital. This crew spent approximately 10 minutes on the scene taking care of this individual. Without the proper training and equipment these people would not be able to do their jobs and save a life. Hats off was given to Captain Jacob Anderson, Firefighter/EMT Tyree Thomas, Firefighter/EMT Eric Del Gatto, Firefighter/EMT Joshua Collier, Probationary Firefighter Evan Solano. A letter of recognition acknowledging their heroic efforts will be placed in each of their personnel files.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor thanked the people for coming out today. A Proclamation was read recognizing Robert A. Helebrandt.

WHEREAS, His Bronze Star Medal was awarded to him as the direct result of him holding a bridge under attack in order for his men to survive, and

WHEREAS, Bob was a member of the American Legion Stickney Post 687, and

WHEREAS, During his years of employment while working on many buildings in the city Robert was a member of the Carpenters Local Union 1889, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Walik, Mayor of the Village of Stickney, do honor the remembrance of Robert A. Helebrandt who portrayed the example of someone who lived an honorable life and a model Stickney resident.


